Dear Friends,

We are proud to present the second release from Jah Love Recordings (IDD-JLR 002). Jah Love Recordings is a part of IDD (Imperial Dub Digital), which is Imperial Dub Recordings production house. DJ Ivan working for Imperial Dub Recordings has built a track record as a DJ and is now expanded to producing with his fellow mates Lazlow & Fionn. We hope to bring quality music to play and enjoy around the world. We are about Positivity, Dub and Grooves. Our tracks hope to be dj friendly and long enough to get your groove on. We believe if you love the San Francisco Sound you will need to have our records.

The tracks:

A1. All Tiings Dub. This track was an experiment in dubby-house done by dj Ivan-I and Fionn Starchild. With additional proccussion from our good friend Jon Nedza (From the infamous Community Recordings on Imperial Dub Recordings-IDR 027). All the sounds, samples and vocals coming directly from dub right down to the kick and snare. Our dream is to cross the dub and house genres together seamlessly. This one, progresses from a minimal beat to a more complex beat as the vocals come in. The bassline drops and takes control of you as you dance. The breakdown is a breakbeat that fakes you out coming back after an extended break. The song has a nice cow bell rhythm from Jon Nedza (Expect more from our friend Jon Nedza in the near future). This one is easy to mix in and out of very steady to flow into the next track. With a bonus dub loop at the end of the record that can be used to trip people out mixing it in and out of other songs.

B1. Cordel. My favorite track on our second release. This track was a collaboration between Ivan-I, Fionn Starchild and Fabricio. Fabricio is taking South America by storm with residencies in Rio and Sao Paulo. This tribal house veteran has recently played in Buenos Aires and in Acapulco at the largest electronic music event ever in Latin America. This is an exotic hard-hitting tribal tech house track with just enough Brazilian spice for the summer. As the track hits the breakdown a full on Barimbou solo hits and takes over the dance floor to make people smile. This track is sure to keep everyone grooving as the bassline kicks after the solo and lifts the crowd up to take you higher. This track has plenty of room from beginning to end to bring in and out other songs to create a tight woven mix. This one also features a bonus Barimbou solo for your mixing pleasure. This can be used over numerous songs to add that little something to build a track even farther.
